When I arrived in January things were hard. We were still in the midst of COVID. Fr. Chris retired without us being able to come together to thank him and support each other. There were questions and concerns about the plan to share a pastor. Who would that be? Would St Matthew's be able to maintain our own parish identity and culture, or would we get blended into some sort of bland homogenized church unfamiliar to us? When would the Mass tickets and masks come to an end? When would we be able to be "Together Again" – for Mass, hospitality, family visits, faith formation, Family Promise, and so much more?

The Hebrew scripture refers to a group of people known as the "Anawim". This faithful remnant had no earthly power to stop whatever held Israel captive. What they did have, was a deep abiding faith and steadfast hope that God would see them through and in the meantime do what they could do. Every heart here at St. Matthew's that has longed to worship and work together again can identify as Anawim. Every staff person and volunteer who re-invented ways of being together again can identify as Anawim.

These Anawim in our midst have made the best of things with live streaming and safety protocols for those attending in person. The Generations of Faith program marshaled on. People called and checked in on one another. Zoom became a thing – an imperfect thing, but still a way for the remnant in each of us to remain connected. Parish events and hospitality started to return. The parish council and staff worked hard with me to be sure that we continued to be the wonderful gem of the Church called St. Matthew's Church.



2020-2021 Faith Development

at St. Matthew's Church

We were incredibly blessed to have so many people continue their faith development journey with us during 2020-21! Between in person and virtual opportunities and with the continued dedication of amazing volunteers, the St. Matthew's programs were well attended and COVID safe!

- Our 2020-21 Generations of Faith parish-wide faith formation program kicked off in October with 74 families registering. The
 theme for the year was "Living The Good News: How Reading the Bible As A Church Guides Our Journey Of Faith." Participants had the choice of meeting in person or watching the taped session from home. The year concluded with a service project called "Tied with Love", created by Brianna Bissel. Brianna began making the hand-tied blankets as a way to help comfort the hospital's hospice patients and their families, and after receiving a grant to make more, reached out to St Matthew's
 for help. The GOF families completed approximately 40 blankets!
- In addition to the GOF program, families participated in a four session virtual Advent wreath lighting experience, five virtual sessions called, "Pray the Rainbow" during Lent and a safety program, both in person and virtually, called "Circles of Grace." The weekly "Seasons of Faith" newsletter continued to be available to parishioners during 2020-21.
- The St. Matthew's sacramental programs started off and finished up strong with 31 candidates receiving 1st Communion in August and November, 2020. The fall season kicked off with a new group of candidates who prepared for the sacrament with three retreats and eight Generations of Faith sessions across the year that included special time for learning about the Mass and communion. In May and June of 2021, 32 candidates made their 1st Communion. Two of the candidates were prepared in 2019-2020, but joined this group to receive the sacrament.
- Following their Mini Confirmation Retreat, 29 teens and two adults received the sacrament of Confirmation at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Albany in October of 2020. We had the privilege to work with eighteen Peer Mentors as they helped candidates learn and prepare for Confirmation. Twenty candidates and sixteen Peer Mentors came together in October 2020 to start a new year of preparation for Confirmation. Teens met for 8 sessions, additionally participating in four service projects including serving meals at the Albany Mission, sorting clothes at Karie Jean's Closet, making blankets for Sleep in Heavenly Peace and helping at St. Matthew's. The group also came together for a bonding experience at Wild Play in Thatcher Park.



• After providing our community with wonderful faith development leadership for six years, Joy Galarneau stepped down. We are grateful for the heart, soul and wisdom she shared with our team and our parish families. Joy created a strong faith development program, nourishing our catechists and staff with her love for God, so we are ready to continue serving our parish family!






