Stricken with tuberculosis he was miraculously healed through prayer, praying to Mother Mary. On June 15, 1941, Patrick Peyton became an ordained priest and his first assignment as a chaplain was to a group of Holy Cross brothers, who taught at Vincentian Institute in Albany, NY. During this time, Fr. Peyton dreamed of establishing the Family Rosary in homes of 10 million. Fr. Peyton then spends his life, with the help of the most iconic celebrities of Hollywood, championing the message world wide, "The family that prays together stays together". Since 2001, Fr.
